



SPRING CLOTHING GUIDELINES

Clothing should be clean, current, complete:

- No pills, stains, rips, holes
- No camp t-shirts
- No vacation t-shirts
- No date specific clothing
- No rec league shirts/shorts
- No DIY tie dye

Hanging Clothes Limits: 250 hangers total (one Z rack) | 50 hanging item limit (per gender) for NB-12 mo clothing, sizes 10/12-Teen girls. Exceptions can be made for boutique and better brands in excellent condition.

Spring Specifics:

*Fabrics **not** accepted at Spring sale = Flannel, velvet, velour, corduroy

*Clothing should be current (i.e. no more than 3-4 years off the retail rack)

*Bagged Clothing gets inspected at Bargain Bin Inspection

Short sleeve shirts + Long sleeve shirts
- NO fall/winter shirts, date-specific,
vacation-specific, rec league/team or
DIY

School Uniforms OK

Athletic wear - exceptions made for
stains on baseball/football pants

Jeans - Best 5 pair only.

Dance wear, leotards and dance
costumes

Unlined jackets, raincoats

Holiday Wear - St. Patricks Day, Easter,
July 4th

Sweatshirts/sweaters/vests (lightweight,
spring/summer colors, theme)

Bathing suits - tug and make sure
elastic isn't dry rotted

PJs - PJ sets, nightgowns
